His long term experience in teaching and previous position as Head of Studies from DTU, allowed him to develop excellent educational skills resulting in broad appreciation from former students. BP has within the last few years been running international mobile workshops in NGS, metagenomics, and bioinformatics in Brazil, China, Colombia, Egypt, India, Malaysia and at the Faroe Islands.

He is also a Deputy Director at COMBio (the Center of Excellence for Omics Driven Computational Biodiscovery) here at AIMST University Malaysia. He has published over 48 articles in reputed journals with more than 3500 citations.
